

FRENCH AS A FOREIGN LANGUAGE (FLE) COURSES FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS ON EXCHANGE PROGRAMS

In Grenoble

Courses take place at the CUEF (University Centre for French Studies) – Stendhal Building - Saint Martin d'Hères Campus.

20 hours of general French courses are provided by the CUEF during the exchange. These courses are free and are worth 3 credits (ECTS).

Students on exchange programs can participate in these courses for one semester only.

A proficiency test to evaluate their level must be taken online.

All four skills are worked on (listening, speaking, reading and writing).

The CUEF issues the students' marks to the relevant faculties, institutes and departments at the end of the evaluation sitting, if required, along with the CEFR level (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages, levels A1-A2-B1- B2-C1-C2) and the number of ECTS credits acquired.

Attendance of courses is compulsory.

In Valence

Students on the exchange program at the IUT in Valence are entitled to 40 hours of courses in French as a Foreign Language (all levels). These courses are free and are worth 4 credits (ECTS).

The international relations contact person for the faculty where you are studying will give you information about how to register for these.

Evaluation: coursework and final CEFR test (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages).

A certificate of completion can be provided at the student's request.
