DUEF B2 courses are intended for foreign students of B2 level and wishing to deepen their language skills while enriching their cultural knowledge.

Students enrolled in the DUEF obtain a university degree in French studies if they pass as well as the transcript of the exam. A certificate indicating the marks obtained as well as the level acquired from the CERCL is given to each student at the end of the semester.

The objectives are as follows :

- Improve the mastery of the spoken and written language
- Deepen specific knowledge in various specialty areas
- Targeted skills: written and oral skills, reception, production and interaction
